

ENTERING THE IDPE 2020 DEVELOPMENT AWARDS

TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2020

- 1. The awards are open to any school or individual whose achievements in the 2018/2019 academic year deserve recognition by the schools' development sector. All entries will be judged against the criteria indicated for each category. Entries from outside the UK will be welcomed. Any submissions in languages other than English must be accompanied by an English translation.
- 2. All work submitted must have been live or have had an impact during the specified period.
- 3. Entries must fulfil the definitions of the category in which they are entering.
- 4. Any supporting work or material to support a nomination should be submitted via email to IDPE and supplied as PDF's or URLs. Video files should not be uploaded but hosted and links provided.
- 5. It is the nominees responsibility to ensure they have written permission from any owner of the supporting material they are wishing to upload. This includes:
 - Literary works such as articles, stories, journals, or computer programs
 - Pictures and graphics
 - Blueprints of architecture
 - Screenplays
 - Audio-visual recordings such as movies
 - Sound recordings
 - PowerPoint presentations
- 6. URLs provided for the website and other campaigns must be live from the point of submission and through to the end of December 2020. Please supply any valid user names or passwords.
- 7. If you have work which needs to be sent directly (e.g. literature, CDs, DVDs) please contact Vicky Roe, Business Manager on 01225 829030 or vicky.roe@idpe.org.uk.
- 8. Entries will be judged by a panel of experts with broad experience of the development sector. Decisions of the judges will be final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. The closing date for entries is 5pm on Friday 24 April 2020, however this may be extended at the discretion of IDPE.
- 13. Entries arriving after the closing date will be considered at the discretion of IDPE.
