

## Murray Lindo Head of the Wellington Community Wellington College

Murray started his career in banking, then retrained to become a teacher (teaching history, geography, drama and coaching sport). Murray then spent the next 20 years working in the not-for-profit sector and has held senior roles at some of the largest charities in the UK, including Macmillan Cancer Support, Samaritans, and Breast Cancer Care. He is also an experienced consultant having worked with a large number of charities, NGOs, and social enterprises on branding, communications, fundraising, organisational development, team building, and coaching, and is also a qualified business psychologist and trained actor.

After 4 Years at Tonbridge Schools as Director of the Foundation, he was appointed Head of the Wellington Community at Wellington College and in his 5<sup>th</sup> year. Along with raising funds for the Widening Opportunity at Wellington (WOW bursary programme) and capital building programme (£18m raised since 2015) - Murray and his team run Wellington's global social and professional Wellington Connect network (4,000 members) for parents (past and present) and OWs as well as providing career advice and support for current students.
