A professional fundraiser for over twenty years, Georgie specialises in establishing and revitalising fundraising operations. A major donor fundraiser by experience, Georgie previously held Development Director roles at LAMDA (the London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art) and St George's Chapel, Windsor Castle. Georgie is joint Regional Vice President of the IDPE Surrey Region and is particularly interested in the opportunities offered by independent schools development to change the educational landscape nationwide and improve education for all. Georgie will be going freelance in summer 2021, partnering with charities to help them kick-start their fundraising.
