Jo began her fundraising career 26 years ago, working on a £27m capital campaign at Birmingham Children's Hospital before moving to work as a Regional Campaign Manager for the NSPCC's £250m Full Stop Campaign.

Since 2010, Jo has been Director of Development at The Royal Latin School in Buckingham – one of the worst funded state schools in England – where she set up the development office and alumni relations programme and has led the creation of a ten year, four phase capital campaign to improve facilities in time for the 600th anniversary of the school in 2023. In 2015, Jo successfully delivered an innovative £5m discovery centre, followed by a £1m 6th form refurbishment in 2017 and is completing a £3m sports campus campaign next month. Phase four, a campaign for an £8m arts centre, will follow.
