Dame Rosemary Squire co-founded Ambassador Theatre Group in 1992, which has gone onto become the world's number one live-theatre company.

Her latest venture is Trafalgar Entertainment, a premium international live entertainment business focussed on new productions and the distribution of live-streaming innovative content. TE is home to Trafalgar Theatre, Theatre Royal Sydney, Trafalgar Theatre Productions, Olympia Theatre, HQ Theatres (with 12 regional theatres), Trafalgar Releasing, Stagecoach Performing Arts, Helen O'Grady Drama Academy, London Theatre Direct, Jonathan Church Theatre Productions and The Chiswick Cinema.

In 2014, she made history as the first woman to be named EY UK Entrepreneur of the Year and was a National Member of the Arts Council England Board for ten years. Rosemary is currently Joint Chairman of The Hall for Cornwall in Truro and Chairman of Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts in London.

In 2007, Rosemary was awarded an OBE for Services to Theatre and in 2018, received a Damehood for Services to Theatre and Philanthropy. Rosemary chaired two major appeals for Great Ormond Street Hospital raising some £20 million and as an alumna of Nottingham High School for Girls she also chaired the successful multi-million campaign to build a Performing Arts Centre at the school, named in her honour, The Space – The Squire Performing Arts Centre.
