Kathryn started her career at Newcastle based children's charity, The Children's Foundation, in 2005, before moving to the University of Leeds as their first Stewardship Officer, setting up a donor relations programme for their £60m fundraising campaign. After moving into UK and US major gift fundraising at Leeds, Kathryn then entered the world of Law, managing the international alumni network at global law firm, Freshfields Bruckhaus Deringer and then onto transatlantic firm, WBD. She returned to the world of education, joining the Global and Transformational Philanthropy Team at the University of Manchester, focusing on North America. She oversaw the US fundraising board and set up the first Leadership Council in Toronto, before joining Harrogate Ladies College in 2020 to build their alumni and development programme.

Alongside the world of alumni relations and fundraising, Kathryn spent 15 years teaching Chartered Institute of Marketing courses to young professionals and runs a small food business.
