Originally from Somerset, Charles Fillingham has spent the last 26 years teaching in London schools. Charles is currently Headmaster at Francis Holland School, Regent's Park, an academically selective, London day school for girls aged 11-18, where he was appointed as its first Headmaster in January 2016.

During his career, Charles has served in boys', girls' and co-educational schools, including five years as Director of Studies and Acting Lead of Lower School at Archbishop Tenison's CE High School in Croydon and eight years as the Deputy Headmaster at City of London School for Boys. He will join Solihull School, a co-educational school for ages 3-18, as its Executive Head in January 2023.

Charles is a modern linguist with a PGCE from Bristol University. He holds two degrees at Masters level, one from Jesus College, Oxford and one from King's College, London. He sits on the Board of the ISEB and is a member of the HMC/GSA Universities Committee and he serves as a governor at Monkton Combe School in Bath.
